# Afternoon Exercise: Lower pasture (Strawberry Pasture) native grass stand measurements (low density)

Teams find assigned pre-marked transect starting point (with GPS), and establishes 25 m transects. Team members take turns measuring and recording native grass frequency.

Group will discuss the outcomes of data collection and any questions from the day's activities.
