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Management Goals and Objectives

The primary goal of the management program is to create wildlife habitat that requires minimal maintenance in the long term. Secondary goals for the project are to increase native plant species diversity and to minimize invasive, non-native plant species establishment.

An intensive three year establishment period maintenance program will be implemented following native plant installation. A two year post establishment maintenance period will further and the success of the restoration efforts. After five years the site will be periodically maintained as required to meet the long term goals of the restoration project.
